Notes:

All Psy.D. students are required to complete seven (7) semesters of practicum. All practicum semesters completed through Spring 2024 are transcribed as PSY 810, Practicum (repeatable for course credit). Students who enrolled in the Psy.D. program prior to Fall 2023 completed PSY 810 in lieu of one or more of the following: PSY 800, 811, 812, 821, and/or 822. Students admitted to the Psy.D. program in 2023-2024 and beyond will take the Basic (811/812), Intermediate (821/822), Advanced (831/832) Practicum course sequence. Summer practica were transcribed as PSY 810 in Summer 2022, and will be transcribed as PSY 800 in Summer 2024 and beyond.

PSY 701 was taken and transcribed as a three-credit class from 2021-2023, and will be taken and transcribed as a four-credit class in 2024 and beyond.

The following courses are repeated multiple times throughout the program:

- PSY 780, Case Consultation, is taken for 4 semesters: Fall 1 and 2; Spring 1 and 2.
- PSY 880, Advanced Case Consultation, is taken for 4 semesters: Fall 3 and 4; Spring 3 and 4.
- PSY 720, Models of Psychotherapy, is taken for 3 semesters: Fall 2 and 3; Spring 3. Topics rotate and are announced prior to registration.
- PSY 901, Dissertation, is taken for 5 semesters: Fall 3 and 4; Spring 3 and 4; and Summer 3. Students who do not defend the dissertation by Spring of the 4th year will continue registering for PSY 901 in each subsequent semester until they pass the final dissertation defense.
- PSY 902, Internship, is taken for 4 semesters: Fall 5, Spring 5, and Summer 4 and 5.
